Joint Health and Safety Committees	Occupational Health and Safety Act
Identify hazards	9(18)(a)
Make recommendations to employer on:	9 (18)(b)
a. Improvements	9(18)(c)
Establishing, maintaining, and monitoring programs,	
measures and procedures	
Consult with employer over any testing program and	9(18)(e),(f)
commencement, and worker designated member be	
present at the commencement	
Maintain and keep minutes of its proceedings, and	9(22)

Meet at least once every three months at the	9(33)
workplace, and when required by the Ministry of	
Labour

Joint Health and Safety Committees	Designated Substances Regulation
Make recommendations to employer on:	19(3)
- Assessments required for designated	
substances, with consultation required;	
- A designated substance control program,	20(7)
measures and procedures to control the	21(4)
worker's exposure to substances, with	
consultation required	
- Notify an inspector over disputes concerning	23(1)
designated substances, and receive the	
inspector's decision in writing	20(0)
- Receive certain limited worker personal	29(6)
medical information on a confidential basis	
concerning exposure to designated	
substances	





Joint Health and Safety Committees	Occupational Health and Safety Act
Can request and obtain:	
- All information necessary for carrying out inspections	9(29)
- Hazard information from the employer relating to its own and similar workplaces	9(18)(d)
- Response to committee recommendations in writing within 21 days, including timetable for implementation, or reason for disagreeing	9(20),(21)
Yearly summary date about the workplace from WSIB and ensure employer posts the data	12(1),(2)
- Assistance and cooperation from employer in carrying our any functions	25(2)(e)
- Copies of the yearly employer health and safety policy and implementation program	25(2)(j),(k)
- Where prescribed (in regulation or policy), written instructions as to measures and procedures to be taken for worker protection	26(1)(k)
- Copies of every unexpired material safety data sheet	38(1)(b)
- Immediate notice about workplace death or injury	51(1)
- Notice in writing within four days about an accident, explosion or fire not causing death or critical injury, about an occupational illness or a claim filed with WSIB about an occupational illness	52(1),(2),(3)
- Copies of any order made by an inspector	57(10)

- Copies of the designated substance	19(4)
